



MA in Aspects and Implications of Biblical Interpretation

Fees for the academic year 2011–12

- ❖ Administrative fee at application is £30.
- ❖ Registration fee is £800.
- ❖ Individual modules cost £849.
- ❖ Therefore the total cost (without adjustment for inflation) is £4200.
- ❖ The discount lump sum amount (covering the modules **and** the registration fee) is £3885.

The standard payment scheme spreads the cost of the MA into five payments. You start by paying the registration fee, and one and a half modules of study. This total of £2057.50 is split into two payments of £1,334 and £723.50, the first payable at the start of the course, the second nine months later.

Having completed the study and assessments we then send you the second module and a half. The payment for this is also split into two payments, nine months apart. Finally, there is the payment for the dissertation module.

If you intend to study more quickly than this four year scheme, the payments will, of course, fall more frequently.

Should you wish to, you can pay the fees for the entire course in advance. The lump sum needs to be paid in full within twelve calendar months of your enrolment to qualify for the discount. If you need to withdraw then you will be refunded the portion of the study not yet begun. Not only does this scheme give you a discount on the whole cost, but also protects you against future price increases.

There is a 20% discount available for missionaries. Students living overseas should also allow for airmail costs.
