

Fees 2011 / 2012

PG Certificate, PG Diploma and MA in Theological Education

Course Structure

Students registered for the PG Certificate study two 30 credit modules. Students aiming to receive the PG Diploma study a further two 30 credit modules and students intending to achieve the MA qualification will in addition need to complete the 60 credit dissertation module. Students can progress from Certificate through Diploma to the MA.

Tuition Fees

Students are charged per module.

30 Credit modules	£ 600
60 Credit modules	£1,200

Therefore, at 2011/12 rates the tuition fees for the Certificate will be £1,200. For the Diploma a further £1,200 and to complete the MA the total tuition fees would be £3,600.

University Registration Fees

In addition students are required to pay a one off Middlesex University Registration fee.

Accommodation Fees

Full Board accommodation can be provided at the School for the Intensive weeks which form part of the Certificate Course. Each 30 credit Certificate module contains one of these weeks and therefore to complete the Certificate you will need to attend two such weeks.

Application Fees

Application fees are payable by all applicants at the point of application. These rates relate to those who apply during 2011/2012.

New Students requiring "Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies." (CAS) for Visa purposes*	£40
New Students (not requiring Visa).	£30
Where students require a second CAS a further fee of £10 will be charged.	
Existing students applying for a further course (not requiring Visa)	£25

* You will need to enquire in your country whether you will need a Visa to enter the UK for the one-week intensive sessions.

Notes on Fees

Tuition Deposit: For students applying to commence in 11/12: £800. Payable to secure a place at the School but deducted from the first Semesters fees (Non refundable after the course start date, or after registration with the University). Payable on confirmation of acceptance to the course.

Tuition Fees: The programme will be delivered in a blended fashion through intensive residential modules, distance education, personal study and reflection on your own practice. The Tuition fee covers the tuition provided on the intensive modules hosted at the London School of Theology as well as that delivered through distance education. It does not cover the residence fees for the intensive weeks. Each Certificate module contains one week of "Intensive" study. There are no "Intensives" at Diploma and MA level.

University Registration Fees: The Registration Fees are set by Middlesex University and are paid over by LST to the University. They are initial one off charges and are invoiced only in the first semester of the first year of study. Part time students will pay the same total registration fees as full time students. Fees for 2011/12 are still to be confirmed by the University and the University's fee structure is currently under review. University Registration Fees cannot be refunded.

Accommodation; Students who do not wish to live in the School's accommodation can pay a day visitor rate and receive meals at the School. Rooms cancelled within one month of the Intensive week will be charged for.

Terms of Payment; Course Fees (except for University Registration fees) are payable by semester in advance. Registration fees are invoiced in the first semester of the first year of study. If you withdraw from your course during the year, full fees will be due for the semester for which you are registered.
